



How to Read Your AEP Ohio Electric Bill

A monthly bill has two main types of charges:

DELIVERY (DISTRIBUTION) CHARGES: Fees paid to the local utility to maintain power lines, read a meter, and manage the billing process.

SUPPLY (GENERATION) CHARGES: The cost of the actual electricity used, measured in kilowatt-hours (kWh).

NOTE: The SOPEC Electric Aggregation program only affects the Supply (Generation) Charge. The local utility sets the Delivery (Distribution) Charge.

The **Price-to-Compare** is the default supply rate charged by the utility if another electricity supplier is not selected.

The **Transmission Service** is a **regulated rate** set by AEP Ohio.

The **Delivery (Distribution) and Customer Charge** are also **regulated rates** set by AEP Ohio.

SOPEC partners with **AEP Energy** to provide the **Supply (Generation) rate**.

This is where a customer will find their rate. Please note, this is a mock supply rate and not necessarily representative of the actual rate. Customers can find the rate for their community at sopec-oh.gov/our-communities.
