



# How to Read Your AES Ohio Electric Bill

A monthly bill has two main types of charges:

**DELIVERY (DISTRIBUTION) CHARGES:** Fees paid to the local utility to maintain power lines, read a meter, and manage the billing process.

**SUPPLY (GENERATION) CHARGES:** The cost of the actual electricity used, measured in kilowatt-hours (kWh).

**NOTE:** The SOPEC Electric Aggregation program only affects the Supply (Generation) Charge. The local utility sets the Delivery (Distribution) Charge.
