



How to Read Your Duke Energy Electric Bill

A monthly bill has two main types of charges:

DELIVERY (DISTRIBUTION) CHARGES: Fees paid to the local utility to maintain power lines, read a meter, and manage the billing process.

SUPPLY (GENERATION) CHARGES: The cost of the actual electricity used, measured in kilowatt-hours (kWh).

NOTE: The SOPEC Electric Aggregation program only affects the Supply (Generation) Charge. The local utility sets the Delivery (Distribution) Charge.

In Case No. 24-39-EL-RDR, the PUCO approved an adjustment to Rider PF (Power Future Initiatives Rider). A typical residential customer using 1,000 kWh per month will see an increase of \$1.00 or 0.61% per month effective May 2025.

Riders are costs the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio has approved to cover investments in improving the energy infrastructure or other additional expenses.

The Service Delivery and Generation Riders are regulated rates set by Duke Energy.
